## Summary of career to date, including key research outputs, grants awarded

Irina Evgheny Ciobanu-Suhomlin, is a Moldovan musicologist, Honoured master of Art of the Republic of Moldova, Professor of the Academy of Music, Theatre and Fine Arts in Chisinau, Department of Musicology, Composition and Jazz, Doctor in Art, Ph.D. in Musicology, Member of Composers and Musicologists Union of Moldova.

Dr. Ciobanu-Suhomlin became a founder and supervisor of musical archivistic researches in the Republic of Moldova which were resulted in editing of some catalogues of musical works composed by Moldovan composers of the 20<sup>th</sup> century (the authors are I. Ciobanu-Suhomlin, L. Balaban, N. Chiciuc) as well as the catalogue of the national folklore melodies.

With the aim of collecting and organize musical information about the composers' creativity, in republic she initiated applicative scientific projects with the financial support of the Supreme Council for Science and Technological Development of the Academy of Science of Moldova, the results of the first project (papers, volumes) were registered by the State Agency for Intellectual Property.

The second area of Mrs. Ciobanu-Suhomlin's innovative activities is scientific research in the field of contemporary music including the creativity of Moldovan composers, as a musicologist, the author of articles and volumes, the adviser of doctoral thesis. Dr. Ciobanu-Suhomlin participates in international musicological and interdisciplinary conferences in the Republic of Moldova, Romania, Ukraine, Russia.

The third area of Mrs. Ciobanu-Suhomlin's professional interest is the music of the Byzantine tradition studies which began on her initiative in the Republic of Moldova. She written the articles, a monograph on different subjects concerning Byzantine manuscripts and old books from the National Archive of the Republic of Moldova, New Neamts Monastery's collection.
